A2.1 The importance of manufacturing devices (jigs)

For the simple execution of difficult construction steps in the production of the LAZOLA, a large number of simple jigs were specially designed. Their use replaces measuring and marking, making work easier and leading to accurate results. The handling of the jigs is easy - even for untrained workers. An experienced craftsmen could manage most of the work without these jigs, but a lot more cumbersome.

The jigs are offered by the Lazola initiative as a complete set. They are delivered on a pallet in a large box made of sturdy wooden plates. In the big box is a smaller one. On site, the two boxes are placed on top of each other like cabinet parts. In the box, all jigs can be clearly arranged. Lockable doors protect jigs and tools from theft, especially when not needed for a longer time.

The jigs are not designed for one piece production. For this their purchase would be unprofitable. They are made to facilitate a small-batch production, making it much simpler, faster and efficient. By using the jigs, all work-pieces are identical and fit exactly to the other cooker parts during assembly. As the overview in appendix A2.2 shows, the jigs have very different forms and functions. Their use is referred to time and again in the construction manual.

Exact instructions for the clear storage of the jigs are enclosed with the delivery.
